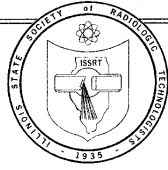

RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR THE 75th ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE ILLINOIS STATE SOCIETY OF RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGISTS

April 14-16, 2010

Normal, IL

REGISTRATION

All members and guests must be properly registered and receive identification badges, which must be clearly visible at ALL TIMES. Proof of status for purposes of registration must be presented or established at the time of registration.

DECORUM

All attendees are expected to adhere to a level of professional behavior. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated, and any conduct deemed disruptive by the hotel or any ISSRT Board member will be dealt with immediately. This may result in the hotel contacting the police and the arrest or removal of the individual(s) involved, with no refund of monies paid for the conference or hotel.

Any damage caused by any individual(s) will be the responsibility of those individuals, not the ISSRT. Individual(s) engaging in disruptive/damaging behavior will be disqualified from competing in the Scholarbowl, and may result in the disqualification of his/her entire team.

The ISSRT will not tolerate any illegal activities. Alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed in any ISSRT sponsored functions including, but not limited to, lectures, competitions or exhibit halls. Violators will be subject to disqualification and removal with no refund of monies paid for the conference or hotel.

Admittance to all business sessions, scientific sessions, special sessions and functions of entertainment will be only to those wearing identification badges and having the appropriate tickets when applicable.

During the business sessions, active, life and student members shall be seated in the sections reserved for voting members. All other registrants shall be seated in the non-reserved sections. During the voting for officers and the annual conference, members who have submitted absentee ballots and have not requested their return will be seated in an area designated by the sergeant-at-arms.

All registrants are requested to be seated promptly prior to the opening of the business and scientific sessions and are requested to maintain a suitable level of courtesy and attention to the speakers and proceedings. Literature distributions, sale of articles or videotaping are prohibited unless written permission has been received from the ISSRT Board of Directors.

BUSINESS SESSIONS

All conference registrants are welcome to attend the business sessions. They shall observe the rules of decorum at all times.

Voting members shall hold current and valid memberships. Only voting members in good standing may introduce business to the Assembly.

All main motions and resolutions must be in writing and presented to the Chair prior to the introduction of the motion or resolution on the floor.

Only voting members may speak and participate in debate. The right to address the Assembly may be granted to a registrant other than a voting member by consent of the Chair or by a majority vote of the voting members present. This rule will also apply to all special sessions.

Voting members who wish to address the Assembly should rise and be recognized by the Chair. The member should give his/her name and district. Members shall speak no more than twice of the same question and no longer than three minutes each time. Extension of this time may be granted by the Chair or by two-thirds vote of the voting members present.

VOTING SESSION

Only those active, life and student members wearing badges and seated in the section reserved for voting members will be allowed to vote.

Elections of officers will take place during the second business session.

If more than two candidates are nominated for a particular office, a plurality vote will prevail.

COMMITTEES

The Chair will be empowered to appoint such committees as shall be necessary for the conduct of the meeting.

MEETING RULES

These rules shall be adopted by a majority vote, but they may be suspended, rescinded, or amended after their adoption by a two-thirds vote of those present and voting, provided a quorum is present.
