Illinois Radiologic Professionals: Your voice is needed!

Two bills currently under consideration in Illinois could impact who is allowed to administer and supervise the use of medical radiation.

The ASRT has submitted a letter opposing SB3238 and HB4779, which would allow advanced practice registered nurses (APRNs) to administer and supervise radiation without requiring the same specialized imaging education and competency standards required of imaging professionals.

Radiologic technologists receive extensive education and clinical training to ensure safe imaging practices and radiation protection for patients.

Take Action

Contact your Illinois legislators (<https://lnkd.in/dKGzT9aJ>) and urge them to protect patient safety and maintain appropriate training standards for those administering radiation.

Sample message: *"I am a constituent and medical imaging professional. I'm asking you to carefully review SB3238 and HB4779. Radiation safety requires specialized education and training. Please support policies that ensure medical imaging and radiation procedures are performed and supervised by appropriately trained professionals to protect patient safety."*
